The healthcare industry is a political football and faces significant financial headwinds. The result is a consistent stream of bankruptcy cases in the healthcare industry. Currently the second largest hospital bankruptcy case in American history is pending in Los Angeles. Many other hospitals have filed chapter 11 or chapter 9 cases in California, including the recently completed Gardens Regional Hospital and West Contra Costa Health Care District cases, as have large skilled nursing facilities operators. This panel will discuss the intersection of the Bankruptcy Code, healthcare statutes and regulations, and not-for-profit law, and its impact on healthcare bankruptcy cases, including unique issues related to the Attorney General's review of not-for-profit sales, the treatment of the Medicare and Medicaid provider agreements, the treatment of donor restricted funds, and other issues.

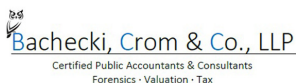
